### Spook-tastic Recipe

#### Terrible Teeth!

An apple a day...will keep the scary-s away! Cut a slice out of an apple. You should be able to get four slices out of an apple. Cut a smaller section out of the slice you just cut out, so that the slice looks like an open mouth. Or cut thin slices of the apple, use two slices to look like the mouth.

Add any kind of nut or cookie butter and place slivered almonds, marshmallows, or yogurt covered raisins, into the apple, near the peel to resemble teeth.
